

## **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

In March 2023, the City of Tampa hosted a two-day public workshop to engage residents and users of the corridor to get their input on how the Twiggs Street corridor can be reimagined to support safe, efficient, multimodal travel options for all roadway users.

The Twiggs Street project started as part of the Florida Department of Transportation's County Incentive Grant Program (CIGP). Tampa was awarded a grant for the segment between Ashley Drive and Nebraska Avenue. Because the segment between Nebraska Avenue and Channelside Drive is on the City's High Injury Network (a network of streets within the City of Tampa with the highest incidence of fatal and severe injury crashes), this segment is also being included in the project.

- Improved roadway safety for all users.
- Better multimodal connections between the Riverwalk and the Channelside district
- Enhanced bicycle and pedestrian facilities
- Improved access to businesses and residential properties along the corridor.
