Bidders on the above referenced project are hereby notified that the following addendum is made to the Contract Documents. BIDS TO BE SUBMITTED SHALL CONFORM TO THIS NOTICE.

- Item 1. Drawings, Sheet No. SP-1 Site Plan/Layout Plan, General Note D: **CLARIFICATION** that any sidewalk and/or street closure (including partial closures) within the Bayshore Boulevard Right-of-Way (ROW), will require a Maintenance-of-Traffic (MOT) Plan to be submitted with the ROW Permit Application. The Contractor shall obtain and submit a drawing defining the proposed MOT Plan to the City/Contract Administration Department for review prior to submitting signed/sealed MOT Plan to the City/Transportation Department for approval.
- Item 2. Drawings, Sheet No. SP-1 Site Plan/Layout Plan, 2/SP-1 Layout Plan: **CLARIFICATION** that layout of the foundation shall be provided utilizing stakes to indicate the orientation shown, and that the Contractor obtain approval of the layout from the City prior to proceeding with the excavation, etc.
- Item 3. Drawings, Sheet No. A-1 Foundation Plan, Sections & Notes, Keynote 6: **CLARIFICATION** that Specialty Formwork shall be similar to the formwork shown in the attached photos (3 pages) of a similar installation by Art Creations & Restorations, LLC. The Contractor shall coordinate with AC&R (Dennis Carhart, ph: 515.833.9300) to facilitate AC&R's timely fabrication, delivery and installation of the specialty formwork to coincide with the formwork, reinforcing, and related scope of work under Contract 15-C-00007.
- Item 4: Attached for reference is the pre-bid meeting sign-in sheet.
