

CITY OF TAMPA EMERGENCY UTILITIES ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

WHAT IS IT?

The City of Tampa received federal funding under the Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP) to assist **RENTERS** who are unable to pay utilities due to the impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic. **The City of Tampa will pay for past due utilities for households that have City of Tampa utilities.** The funds are for payment towards past-due and current utility bills should they still be impacted by COVID-19.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

ERAP is open for eligible **RENTERS** at or below 80% Area Median Income (AMI) or with zero income at the time of application date. Review eligibility criteria and requirements before applying. Financial assistance is awarded on a first-come basis and while funding remains available.
