Presentations

A. Gwendolyn Henderson, CRA Board, Chair

CRA Board Chair, Gwendolyn Henderson addressed the members of the East Tampa Community Advisory Committee (ETCAC). Topics discussed:

- CRA leadership changes; Fair Oaks Park; Destinations/ Faith Baptist Church and absence following
 the passing of her mother. Chair Henderson shared that she wants the best for East Tampa and
 appreciates everyone's involvement.
- ETCAC members asked questions related to residential owner-occupied rehabilitation programs; elimination of committees; measuring progress in East Tampa; staff recommendations on programs and budget; project updates and tracking.
- B. 4603 N. 19th Street Property Purchase

Cedric McCray, ETCRA Manager presented on the purchase of the property at 4603 N. 19th Street for \$400,000 and \$20,000 towards the overall purchase and closing cost. Acquisition of the property would allow for an additional ingress and egress point to lost previously purchase in 2023 for the purpose of affordable housing. The parcel is .46 acres and if acquired, would total the site assemblage of all five lots to 4.48 acres. This is a unique opportunity to establish a catalyst site for redevelopment. The seller has agreed to a purchase price of \$400,000 and closing costs at approximately \$20,000, totaling a CRA acquisition allocation of \$420,000. East Tampa CRA Budget has funds to support this transaction and further housing initiatives through strategic acquisitions. The purchase would be on June 13, 2024, CRA Board agenda for approval. There were several questions and concerns from ETCAC members related to future plans on the parcels being assembled by the East Tampa CRA related to pass history. purchase process and necessity to purchase the property.

There was a motion (Ziegler/Paris) to recommend the purchase of 4603 N. 19th Street in the amount of \$420,500. The motion passed with C. Burton voting no.

C. East Tampa CRA FY25 Budget

East Tampa CRA Manager covered the ETCAC recommended changes on the various budget line items following the May 28th budget workshop. \$1.4 million were allocated to a grand total of \$12.9 million dollars. Final recommendations will be presented to the CRA Board on July 25, 2024. There are anticipated changes or future adjustments to the budget amount once the updated TIF allocations are confirmed by the taxing authorities in July 2024. Mr. McCray will make himself available to answer questions on the FY25 budget. ETCAC members asked questions related to utilities expenses, previous budget allocations and \$1.5 million in funds designated for the stormwater retention pond on North 22nd Street.
