Presentations

A. 1911 E. Osborne Avenue Purchase, Cedric McCray

Cedric McCray, ETCRA Manager presented on the purchase of the property at 1911 E. Osborne for \$617,500 and \$20,000 towards the overall purchase and closing cost. Acquisition of the property would allow for an additional ingress and egress point to lost previously purchase in 2023 for the purpose of affordable housing. The purchase would be on May 9, 2024, CRA Board agenda for approval. There were several questions on the purchase process and necessity to purchase the property. ETCAC members expressed concerns related to the overall plans for future development on site purchased by the ETCRA. They would like to see the process move forward to ensure there are affordable housing options within East Tampa. There was a motion (Ziegler/Paris) to recommend the purchase of 1911 E. Osborne Avenue in the amount of \$637,500. The motion failed with N.C. Miller abstaining.

B. Faith Baptist Church Community Engagement Update – Evan Johnson, City Planning Department

Evan Johnson, with the City of Tampa Planning Department provided an update on the April 20, 2024, community meeting for the ETCRA owned site at Osborne Avenue and 12th Street. Mr. Johnson discussed the 2.7 acres site and the types of future land uses and zoning. Commercial and residential development is allowable on the current site and shared examples of the types of residential development that is allowable. Architectural styles, building heights and visual preference board results were shared with the ETCAC from the April 20th meeting. Mr. Johnson reviewed what makes a streetscape related to sidewalks, curbing, street trees and landscaping. Possible mobility improvements related to crosswalks, signage and bike lanes were shared. The online survey results based on elements residents felt were shared were important to them. There was little support for keeping the existing structure based on community input. Participants felt it was important to ensure housing was affordable for local incomes. Planning will follow-up in the Fall of 2024 with concepts on single family, mixed residential and mixed use and mixed residential. There will be an RFP process to develop construction plans following the Fall 2024 presentation. ETCAC members had an opportunity to ask questions of Mr. Johnson related to next steps and the process moving forward.

C. Capital Projects Update – Melisa Martinez, Tampa CRAs Senior Projects Supervisor

Ms. Martinez covered project updates that were provided in the May 7th meeting agenda packets. She addressed questions related to stormwater ponds; Memorial Park Cemetery; and Gator building. The ETCAC requested beginning and ending dates for the listed projects.
