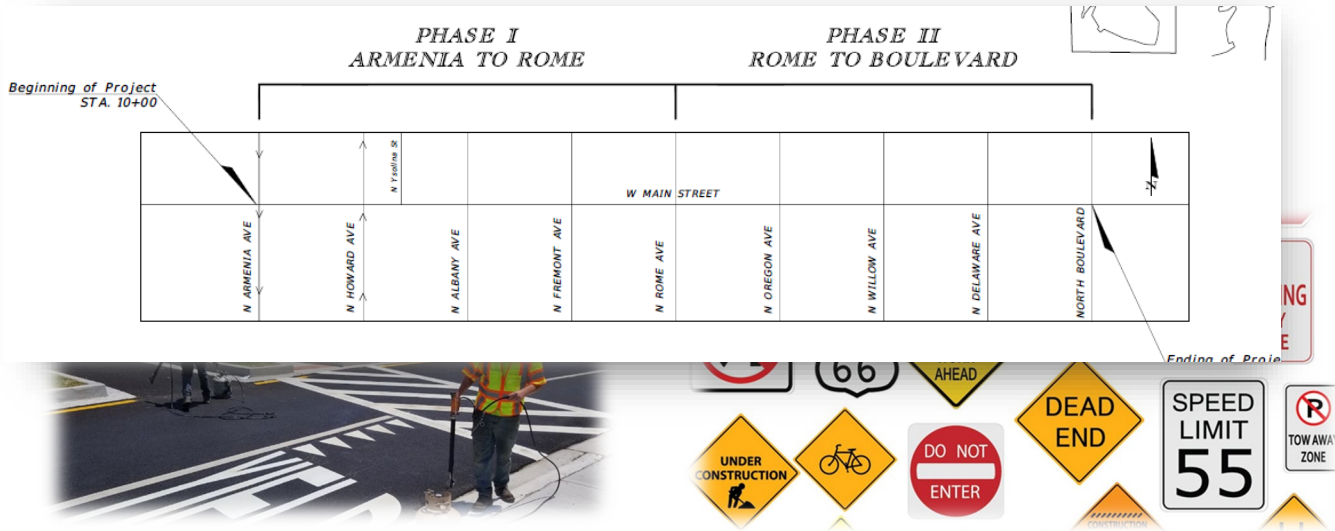


WEST MAIN STREET SIGNING AND PAVEMENT MARKING QUICK-BUILD

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project involves enhancing the safety and functionality of West Tampa's Main Street. Key activities include repaving (Armenia to Rome) the replacement and strategic addition of traffic signs to improve visibility and guidance, as well as the application of durable thermoplastic pavement markings for on-street parking spaces and intersection lines. This initiative aims to create a safer, more efficient road network for all users.
