The purpose of this special call public meeting is to solicit citizen comment and to adopt a list of specific projects to be funded by the City's share of the renewal of the half-cent (0.5%) local government infrastructure surtax for community investment, known locally as the Community Investment Tax or CIT (if approved by the electorate of the County) and to approve an interlocal agreement related thereto, at which hearing all citizens and interested parties may appear and be heard as to any and all matters pertinent to the List of City Projects.

TO SPEAK DURING THE PUBLIC HEARING REMOTELY WITH THE USE OF CMT, PRE-REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED:

You will then be contacted with additional instructions on how to participate live through the use of CMT. Registration for speaking **remotely** must be requested at least **24 hours prior to the meeting**.

Should any person desire to appeal any decision of the Tampa City Council with respect to any matter to be considered at this meeting, that person shall ensure that a verbatim record of the proceeding is made including all testimony and evidence upon which any appeal may be based ([F.S. 286.0105](#)).
