

DOWNTOWN

Downtown Tampa is the oldest part of modern Tampa, dating back to the creation of Fort Brooke in 1824. The Village of Tampa grew up just north of the fort and by 1855 that village became a city. As a southern city, a portion of the population consisted of enslaved Black people. Following the Civil War and into the late 1800s, the northern end of Tampa, from Polk Street north, saw a concentration of African American residents and businesses.

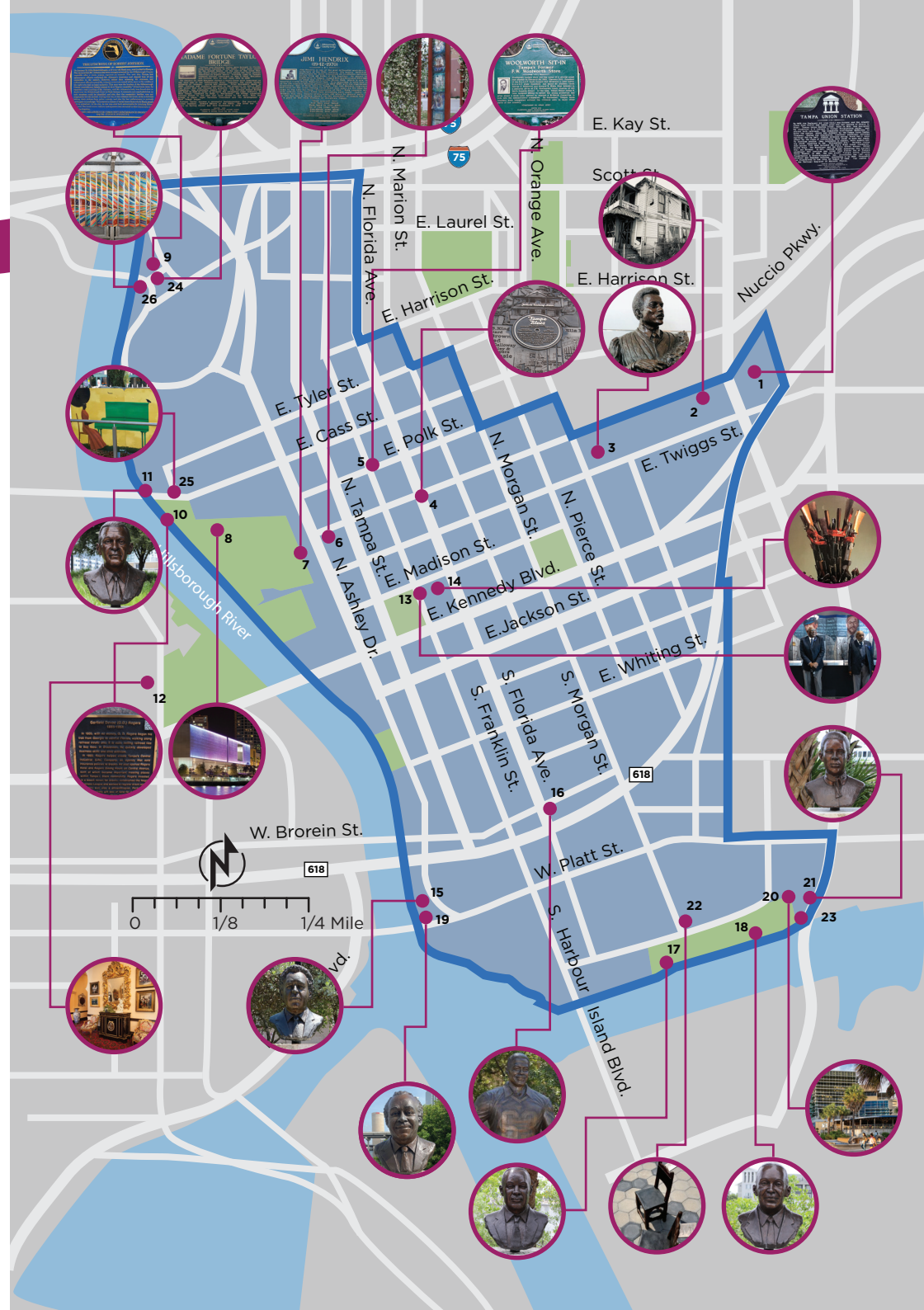

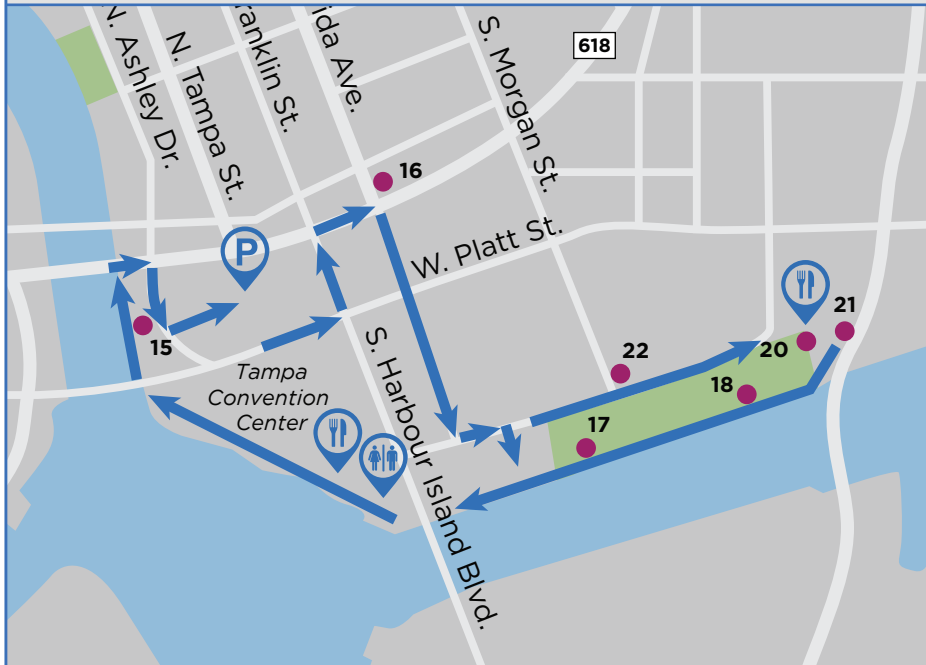
