WHEREAS, in 1987, the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC) established June 26th as the International Day Against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking to raise awareness and reaffirm that illicit drugs continue to pose a threat to health and public safety in our communities, and they promote various initiatives and campaigns with this year's theme "The evidence is clear: invest in prevention," and messages such as *Make Health Your 'New High' in Life, Not Drugs*, to help encourage and empower individuals, especially the youth of the world, to lead healthy, drug-free lifestyles; and

WHEREAS, the Foundation for a Drug Free World is a non-profit organization with a worldwide network of volunteers and its mission is empowering youth and adults with information about drugs to enable them to make informed decisions and live drug-free lives, and it accomplishes its goals by distributing educational materials to thousands of schools and more than 800 law enforcement agencies, participating in drug education lectures, and other activities and events that promote drug-free living; and

WHEREAS, locally, the Foundation for a Drug-Free World Florida Chapter is participating in the United Nations' International Day Against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking with its Cycling for a Drug-Free Florida event to raise awareness for this global initiative through its continued efforts to educate others to live drug-free; and
