WHEREAS, One Church One Child of Florida, established in 1988, is a faith-based, nonprofit organization that strives to reach out to the community to find families for children and find support for adoptive and foster families; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of National Adoption Month and to increase the awareness of the need for adoptive and foster parents, One Church Once Child of Florida in Hillsborough County is participating in Applebee's Dining To Donate on November 26, 2012 whereby ten percent of the diner's bill at Applebee's Restaurant located at 829 Providence Road in Brandon, Florida will be donated to Once Church Once Child towards its efforts to promote adoption.
