WHEREAS, the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP) formed in 1909 is the oldest, largest and strongest civil rights organization in the United States of America and remains relevant in championing justice for all people; and

WHEREAS, having a long, tumultuous and rewarding history, the real story of the nation's most significant civil rights organization lies in the hearts and minds of the people who would not stand still while the rights of some of America's citizens were denied; and

WHEREAS, from the ballot box to the classroom, the dedicated workers, organizers and leaders who forged this great organization and worked to maintain its status as a champion of social justice, fought long and hard to ensure that the voices of African Americans would be heard and from bold investigations of mob brutality, protests of mass murders, segregation and discrimination, it was the talent and tenacity of NAACP members that saved lives and changed many negative aspects of American society; and

WHEREAS, the principal objective of the NAACP is to ensure the political, educational, social and economic equality of minority group citizens of the United States in the electoral process and is actively engaged in increasing the African American responsiveness of citizens to be fully engaged in the democratic process; and

WHEREAS, the Hillsborough County NAACP, established in 1917, has provided the Tampa Bay area with solutions to many of the problems that plague our society, including violent crimes, unemployment, health care and education, and it seeks to remove barriers of racial discrimination through normal democratic processes, informs legislatures of the importance of enacting laws securing civil rights to end discrimination, and is committed to our community to secure Civil Rights for all its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Hillsborough County NAACP will host its signature Freedom Fund Dinner on Saturday, October 25, 2014 at the Hilton Tampa Downtown Hotel with the theme *All In For Justice and Equality* featuring speaker The Honorable James Clyburn, United States Representative for South Carolina's 6th Congressional District, and it will be an evening of inspiration, motivation and entertainment with the proceeds benefiting local programs including those involving health, education, economic development and youth services.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bob Buckhorn, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Tampa, Florida, do hereby proclaim October 25, 2014 as
