**WHEREAS**, the proceeds from the Annual Mayor's Latino's Unidos Luncheon assist Hispanic students in financial need, and the University of South Florida, Hillsborough Community College, and the University of Tampa have benefited from the efforts of this Council through the endowment of \$961,000 in scholarships; and

**WHEREAS**, Hispanics have greatly enhanced our way of life in the fields of science, technology, government, business, education, the arts, and many other important areas, and Hispanic men and women have served a significant role in the development and progress of the United States, the state of Florida, and the city of Tampa; and
