**WHEREAS**, born in Cuba, this year's honoree is **Patsy Sanchez**, who came to the United States at age thirteen and thereafter attended the University of South Florida where she received her Bachelor's Degree in Psychology and Spanish Literature and her Master's Degree in Spanish, and she currently serves as the Director of Diversity and Inclusion and also the Latino Scholarship Program for the University of South Florida (USF); and

WHEREAS, Ms. Sanchez consistently demonstrates her commitment to the Tampa Bay community and to education through her leadership and mentoring of others, especially students, and is dedicated to assisting and guiding educational opportunities and scholarships for Latino students, and she accomplishes this through successfully partnering with local, state and national organizations, foundations and corporations and with the *Undocumented Scholarship Program* at USF, an initiative she established for undocumented students or the children of undocumented parents. Ms. Sanchez is actively involved in leadership roles with numerous organizations including chairing the Mayor's Hispanic Advisory Council, serving on the Board of the Hillsborough County Hispanic Educators Task Force, and volunteering with Eckerd Kids; and

WHEREAS, recognized by the community for her service and many contributions, Ms. Sanchez has been featured in local and national journals for her research and efforts on Latino student success, she received the University of South Florida's Hispanic Heritage Leadership Award twice and its Hispanic Heritage Service Award, selected as Spanish language publication Siete Dias' Hispana Ejemplar, and she was honored with the Hillsborough County Sheriff's Office Council's Hispanic Advocate Award; and
