WHEREAS, crime scene investigators, forensic examiners, and forensic scientists, including the members of the Tampa Police Department's Forensic Investigation Unit (FIU) are dedicated to providing unbiased, accurate, and reliable analysis of evidence recovered, and committed to proper scientific investigations for the cause of justice; and

WHEREAS, National Forensic Science Week was established to recognize and advance quality forensic science, and to bring awareness to the public about the importance of forensic science in modern criminal justice and the dedication demonstrated by forensic professionals in our community and around the nation; and

WHEREAS, the Tampa Police Department's Forensic Investigation Unit will bring awareness to Forensic Science with a large Crime Lab display on Franklin Street in downtown Tampa and provide the opportunity for the public to learn more about their role and how it supports law enforcement.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bob Buckhorn, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the city of Tampa, Florida, do hereby proclaim September 17-23, 2017 as
