WHEREAS, founded in 1959 by the Brass City detachment of the Marine Corps League in Waterbury, Connecticut, the Young Marines is a community based youth program for boys and girls ages eight through completion of high school, and its motto is Strengthening the lives of America's Youth; and

**WHEREAS**, the mission of the Young Marines is to positively impact America's future by providing quality youth development programs for boys and girls that nurtures and develops them into responsible citizens who enjoy and advocate a healthy, drug-free lifestyle, and the organization is dedicated to promoting the mental, moral and physical development of its members, and the Young Marine's National Program has been honored with the United States Secretary of Defense's Fulcrum Shield Award for its efforts in developing responsible citizenship; and

WHEREAS, Red Ribbon Week was established by the United States Congress in 1988 to encourage a drug-free lifestyle and involvement in drug prevention and reduction efforts, and the Young Marine organization believes that one person can make a difference through their commitment to its motto Our Mission is Possible to Live in a Drug Free Community and to Impacting America's future – one Young Marine at a time.
