WHEREAS, under Mr. Fontana's leadership, the award-winning Seminole Hard Rock Hotel and Casino Tampa has grown to be one of the largest and most profitable casinos in the United States, currently the largest in the state of Florida that contributes greatly to the economic success of the Tampa Bay area, and a \$700 million site expansion and enhancement is planned; and
