



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PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project aims to enhance multimodal connectivity in the East Tampa neighborhood. The proposed plan involves developing the currently unimproved right-of-way along North 24th Street, from E Chelsea Street to E Emma Street. The project includes construction of a one-way roadway with new sidewalk on the east side of the road, installation of a new RRFB (Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon) and enhanced midblock crosswalk and implementing additional drainage infrastructure.

BENEFITS TO THE COMMUNITY

- Increased multimodal connectivity with a new sidewalk connection on the east side of N 24th St between E Emma St and E Chelsea St.
- Improved safety and visibility through the installation of an RRFB and enhanced, mid-block crosswalk near Ferrell Girls Preparatory Academy.
- Improved roadway network connectivity through access to parcels along N 24th Street that will be developed for affordable housing.
